Ana M. Osorio is an associate professor in the [Department of Economics](#), and a member of the [Research Group in Economics, Management and Health](#) at the Pontificia Universidad Javeriana in Cali, Colombia. In 2017, she founded the [Research Program on the Measurement of Childhood Well-Being \(PIMBN\)](#). Her program has since become a part of the Latin America Social Debt Observatories Network ([Red ODSAL](#) for its acronyms in spanish). Professor Osorio holds a Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Barcelona, Spain. Her research has focused mainly on the construction and analysis of childhood well-being indicators, as well as the study of socioeconomic determinants of child and maternal health and the role of the context where they live. In 2017, she earned the *Marta Arango Reward for Early Childhood Research*, for her work "Early Childhood and social exclusion in Colombia. A measurement proposal". The prize was awarded by the Glen Nimnicht Scholarship Fund for Early Childhood and the Action Fund/CINDE. Dr Osorio's research has been published in important journals such as: Child Indicators Research, Journal of Biosocial Science, International Journal of Public Health, BMC Public Health and Revista de Saúde Pública.
